

HOW TO READ A UC SANTA BARBARA MAJOR PROGRESS CHECK

A major progress check is an individualized report that lists your progress towards satisfaction of all University, College (including general education), and major requirements.

Students in available majors can run a degree audit at any time through [GOLD](#), (click on 'Progress' at the top, then on 'Major and GE Progress Checks,' then click on the blue 'Degree Audit' tab). If you have any questions on anything in your major progress check, contact your College and/or major department adviser *immediately*.

Please consult the UCSB General Catalog for more information on all degree requirements.

General Information

- Each degree requirement is reported in one of three ways:

+ ✓ OK	University GPA Requirement	OK (satisfied, with a green check)
+ ✗ No	Unit Requirements	NO (not satisfied, with a red 'x')

- Each degree sub-requirements is reported in one of three ways:
